Editors Note

As believers, we know that there is NOTHING more powerful than the Word of God. In fact, scripture tells us that The Word of God IS QUICK AND POWERFUL AND SHARPER THAN ANY TWO EDGED SWORD (Heb 4:12). Tell him that you are sitting in Christ Jesus at the right hand of the Heavenly Father, far above every name (sickness, diseases, infirmity, family problems, etc) that is named (Phil 2:9-11) and he and his demons MUST submit to the name of Jesus Christ. Literally pray 2Cor. 10:5 out loud and watch how fast Satan flees from you. ATTACK, ATTACK, ATTACK!!!

Ahab

Gen 1:26 And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle,

and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.

Gen 2:18-20, 22-23 And the Lord God said, {It is} not good that the man should be alone; I will make him an help meet for him. (19) And out of the ground the Lord God formed every beast of the field, and every fowl of the air; and brought {them} unto Adam to see what he would call them: and whatsoever Adam called every living creature, that {was} the name thereof. (20) And Adam gave names to all cattle, and to the fowl of the air, and to every beast of the field; but for Adam there was not found an help meet for him. (22) And the rib, which the Lord God had taken from man, made he a woman, and brought her unto the man. (23) And Adam said, This {is} now bone of my bones, and flesh of my flesh: she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man.

Gen 18:17,19 And the Lord said, Shall I hide from Abraham that thing which I do; (19) For I know him, that he will command his children and his household after him, and they shall keep the way of the Lord, to do justice and judgment; that the Lord may bring upon Abraham that which he hath spoken of him.

Col 1:21-22 And you, that were sometime alienated and enemies in {your} mind by wicked works, yet now hath he reconciled (22) In the body of his flesh through death, to

present you holy and unblameable and unreproveable in his sight:

2 Tim 1:10 But is now made manifest by the appearing of our Saviour Jesus Christ, who hath abolished death, and hath brought life and immortality to light through the gospel:

Heb 2:9,14,15 But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death, crowned with glory and honour; that he by the grace of God should taste death for every man. (14) Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil; (15) And deliver them who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage.

Heb 11:5 By faith Enoch was translated that he should not see death; and was not found, because God had translated him: for before his translation he had this testimony, that he pleased God.

1 Pet 3:18 For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh, but quickened by the spirit:

1 John 3:14 We know that we have passed from death unto life, because we love the brethren. He that loveth not {his} brother abideth in death

Psa 101:5 Whoso privily slandereth his neighbour, him will I cut off: him that hath an high look and a proud heart will not I suffer.

Psa 109:1-2 Hold not thy peace, O God of my praise; (2) For the mouth of the wicked and the mouth of the deceitful are opened against me: they have spoken against me with a lying tongue.

Psa 119:78 Let the proud be ashamed; for they dealt perversely with me without a cause: {but} I will meditate in thy precepts.

Psa 120:2 Deliver my soul, O Lord, from lying lips, {and} from a deceitful tongue.

Prov 26:26 {Whose} hatred is covered by deceit, his wickedness shall be shewed before the {whole} congregation.

Prov 28:18 Whoso walketh uprightly shall be saved: but {he that is} perverse {in his} ways shall fall at once.

Jer 7:8 Behold, ye trust in lying words, that cannot profit.

Jer 17:9 The heart {is} deceitful above all {things}, and desperately wicked: who can know it?

Jer 48:10 Cursed {be} he that doeth the work of the Lord deceitfully, and cursed {be} he that keepeth back his sword from blood.

Deut 20:8 And the officers shall speak further unto the people, and they shall say, What man {is there that is} fearful and fainthearted? let him go and return unto his house, lest his brethren's heart faint as well as his heart

Psa 23:4 Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for thou {art} with me; thy rod and thy staff they comfort me.

Psa 27:1,3 The Lord {is} my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? the Lord {is} the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid? (3) Though an host should encamp against me, my heart shall not fear: though war should rise against me, in this {will} I {be} confident.

Psa 34:4 I sought the Lord, and he heard me, and delivered me from all my fears.

Psa 46:1,2 God {is} our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble.

(2) Therefore will not we fear, though the earth be removed, and though the mountains be carried into the midst of the sea;

Psa 49:5 Wherefore should I fear in the days of evil, {when} the iniquity of my heels shall compass me about?

Psa 64:1 Hear my voice, O God, in my prayer: preserve my life from fear of the enemy.

Psa 118:6 The Lord {is} on my side; I will not fear: what can man do unto me?

Prov 1:33 But whoso hearkeneth unto me shall dwell safely, and shall be quiet from fear of evil

Prov 3:25 Be not afraid of sudden fear, neither of the desolation of the wicked, when it cometh.

Isa 35:4 Say to them {that are} of a fearful heart, Be strong, fear not: behold, your God will come {with} vengeance, {even} God {with} a recompence; he will come and save you.

Matt 10:28 And fear not them which kill the

body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather fear him which is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.

Rom 8:15 For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.

2 Tim 1:7 For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.

Heb 2:14-15 Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil; (15) And deliver them who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage.

1 John 4:18 There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love.

Hate

Deut 7:10 And repayeth them that hate him to their face, to destroy them: he will not be slack to him that hateth him, he will repay him to his face.

Deut 19:11 But if any man hate his neighbour, and lie in wait for him, and rise up against him, and smite him mortally that he die, and fleeth into one of these cities:

Lev 19:17 Thou shalt not hate thy brother in thine heart....

2 Sam 22:41 Thou hast also given me the necks of mine enemies, that I might destroy them that hate me.

Job 8:22 They that hate thee shall be clothed with shame; and the dwelling place of the wicked shall come to nought.

Psa 21:8-9 Thine hand shall find out all thine enemies: thy right hand shall find out those that hate thee. (9) Thou shalt make them as a fiery oven in the time of thine anger: the Lord shall swallow them up in his wrath, and the fire shall devour them.

Psa 34:21 Evil shall slay the wicked: and they that hate the righteous shall be desolate.

Psa 35:19 Let not them that are mine enemies wrongfully rejoice over me: {neither} let them wink with the eye that hate me

without a cause

Psa 41:7,10,11 All that hate me whisper together against me: against me do they devise my hurt. (10) But thou, O Lord, be merciful unto me, and raise me up, that I may requite them. (11) By this I know that thou favourest me, because mine enemy doth not triumph over me.

Psa 68:1 Let God arise, let his enemies be scattered: let them also that hate him flee before him.

Psa 69:14 Deliver me out of the mire, and let me not sink: let me be delivered from them that hate me, and out of the deep waters.

Psa 86:17 Shew me a token for good; that they which hate me may see {it}, and be ashamed: because thou, Lord, hast holpen me, and comforted me.

Psa 89:22-23 The enemy shall not exact upon him; nor the son of wickedness afflict him. (23) And I will beat down his foes before his face, and plague them that hate him.

Psa 118:7 The Lord taketh my part with them that help me: therefore shall I see {my desire} upon them that hate me.

Matt 5:21-22 Ye have heard that it was said by them of old time, Thou shalt not kill; and whosoever shall kill shall be in danger of the judgment: (22) But I say unto you, That whosoever is angry with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the judgment: and whosoever shall say to his brother, Raca, shall be in danger of the council: but whosoever shall say, Thou fool, shall be in danger of hell fire

Titus 3:3 For we ourselves also were sometimes foolish, disobedient, deceived, serving divers lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hateful, {and} hating one another.

Jezebel

Gen 2:22-23 And the rib, which the Lord God had taken from man, made he a woman, and brought her unto the man. (23) And Adam said, This {is} now bone of my bones, and flesh of my flesh: she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man.

Gen 3:16 Unto the woman he said, I will greatly multiply thy sorrow and thy conception; in sorrow thou shalt bring forth children; and thy desire {shall be} to thy husband, and he shall rule over thee.

Num 30:3-8,12 If a woman also vow a vow unto the Lord, and bind {herself} by a bond, {being} in her father's house in her youth; (4) And her father hear her vow, and her bond wherewith she hath bound her soul. and her father shall hold his peace at her; then all her vows shall stand, and every bond wherewith she hath bound her soul shall stand. (5) But if her father disallow her in the day that he heareth: not any of her yows, or of her bonds wherewith she hath bound her soul, shall stand: and the Lord shall forgive her, because her father disallowed her. (6) And if she had at all an husband, when she vowed, or uttered ought out of her lips, wherewith she bound her soul: (7) And her husband heard {it}, and held his peace at her in the day that he heard {it}: then her vows shall stand, and her bonds wherewith she bound her soul shall stand. (8) But if her husband disallowed her on the day that he heard {it}; then he shall make her vow which she vowed, and that which she uttered with her lips, wherewith she bound her soul, of none effect: and the Lord shall forgive her. (12) But if her husband hath utterly made them void on the day he heard {them; then} whatsoever proceeded out of her lips concerning her vows, or concerning the bond of her soul, shall not stand: her husband hath made them void; and the Lord shall forgive her.

I Kings 21:23 And of Jezebel also spake the Lord, saying, the dogs shall eat Jezebel by the wall of Jezreel.

Prov 6:26 For by means of a whorish woman {a man is brought} to a piece of bread: and the adulteress will hunt for the precious life.

Prov 9:13 A foolish woman {is} clamorous: {she is} simple, and knoweth nothing.

Prov 11:16,22 A gracious woman retaineth honour.... (22) {As} a jewel of gold in a swine's snout, {so is} a fair woman which is without discretion.

Prov 12:4 A virtuous woman {is} a crown to her husband: but she that maketh ashamed {is} as rottenness in his bones.

Prov 14:1 Every wise woman buildeth her house: but the foolish plucketh it down with

her hands

Prov 19:13 A foolish son {is} the calamity of his father: and the contentions of a wife {are} a continual dropping.

Prov 21:19 {It is} better to dwell in the wilderness, than with a contentious and an angry woman.

Prov 31:10-31 Who can find a virtuous woman? for her price {is} far above rubies. (11) The heart of her husband doth safely trust in her, so that he shall have no need of spoil. (12) She will do him good and not evil all the days of her life. (13) She seeketh wool, and flax, and worketh willingly with her hands. (14) She is like the merchants' ships: she bringeth her food from afar. (15) She riseth also while it is yet night, and giveth meat to her household, and a portion to her maidens. (16) She considereth a field, and buyeth it: with the fruit of her hands she planteth a vineyard. (17) She girdeth her loins with strength, and strengtheneth her arms. (18) She perceiveth that her merchandise {is} good: her candle goeth not out by night. (19) She layeth her hands to the spindle, and her hands hold the distaff. (20) She stretcheth out her hand to the poor; yea, she reacheth forth

her hands to the needy. (21) She is not afraid of the snow for her household: for all her household {are} clothed with scarlet. (22) She maketh herself coverings of tapestry; her clothing {is} silk and purple. (23) Her husband is known in the gates, when he sitteth among the elders of the land. (24) She maketh fine linen, and selleth {it}; and delivereth girdles unto the merchant. (25) Strength and honour {are} her clothing; and she shall rejoice in time to come. (26) She openeth her mouth with wisdom; and in her tongue {is} the law of kindness. (27) She looketh well to the ways of her household, and eateth not the bread of idleness. (28) Her children arise up, and call her blessed; her husband {also}, and he praiseth her. (29) Many daughters have done virtuously, but thou excellest them all. (30) Favour {is} deceitful, and beauty {is} vain: {but} a woman {that} feareth the Lord, she shall be praised. (31) Give her of the fruit of her hands; and let her own works praise her in the gates.

Ecc 7:26 And I find more bitter than death the woman, whose heart is snares and nets, and her hands as bands: whoso pleaseth God shall escape from her, but the sinner shall be taken by her.

Matt 8:14-15 And when Jesus was come into Peter's house, he saw his wife's mother laid, and sick of a fever. (15) And he touched her hand, and the fever left her: and she arose, and ministered unto them.

1 Cor 9:5 Have we not power to lead about a sister, a wife,

1 Cor 11:3, 5-10 But I would have you know, that the head of every man is Christ; and the head of the woman {is} the man; and the head of Christ {is} God. (5) But every woman that prayeth or prophesieth with {her} head uncovered dishonoureth her head: for that is even all one as if she were shaven. (6) For if the woman be not covered, let her also be shorn; but if it be a shame for a woman to be shorn or shaven, let her be covered. (7) For a man indeed ought not to cover {his} head, forasmuch as he is the image and glory of God: but the woman is the glory of the man. (8) For the man is not of the woman: but the woman of the man. (9) Neither was the man created for the woman; but the woman for the man. (10) For this cause ought the woman to have power on {her} head because of the angels.

Eph 5:22-24 Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, as unto the Lord. (23) For the husband is the head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of the church: and he is the saviour of the body. (24) Therefore as the church is subject unto Christ, so {let} the wives {be} to their own husbands in every thing.

Col 3:18 Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, as it is fit in the Lord.

1 Tim 2:9-15 In like manner also, that women adorn themselves in modest apparel, with shamefacedness and sobriety; not with broided hair, or gold, or pearls, or costly array; (10) But (which becometh women professing godliness) with good works. (11) Let the woman learn in silence with all subjection. (12) But I suffer not a woman to teach, nor to usurp authority over the man, but to be in silence. (13) For Adam was first formed, then Eve. (14) And Adam was not deceived, but the woman being deceived was in the transgression. (15) Notwithstanding she shall be saved in childbearing, if they continue in faith and charity and holiness with sobriety.

1 Tim 3:11 Even so {must their} wives {be} grave, not slanderers, sober, faithful in all

things.

1 Tim 5:11-15 But the younger widows refuse: for when they have begun to wax wanton against Christ, they will marry; (12) Having damnation, because they have cast off their first faith. (13) And withal they learn {to be} idle, wandering about from house to house; and not only idle, but tattlers also and busybodies, speaking things which they ought not. (14) I will therefore that the younger women marry, bear children, guide the house, give none occasion to the adversary to speak reproachfully. (15) For some are already turned aside after Satan.

2 Tim 3:5-6 Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away. (6) For of this sort are they which creep into houses, and lead captive silly women laden with sins, led away with divers lusts...

Titus 2:3-5 The aged women likewise, that {they be} in behaviour as becometh holiness, not false accusers, not given to much wine, teachers of good things; (4) That they may teach the young women to be sober, to love their husbands, to love their children, (5) {To be} discreet, chaste, keepers at home, good,

obedient to their own husbands, that the word of God be not blasphemed.

1 Pet 3:1 Likewise, ye wives, {be} in subjection to your own husbands; that, if any obey not the word, they also may without the word be won by the conversation of the wives:

Rev 2:20 Notwithstanding I have a few things against thee, because thou sufferest that woman Jezebel, which calleth herself a prophetess, to teach and to seduce my servants to commit fornication, and to eat things sacrificed unto idols.

Judgements

Deut 21:22,23 And if a man have committed a sin worthy of death, and he be to be put to death, and thou hang him on a tree: (23) His body shall not remain all night upon the tree, but thou shalt in any wise bury him that day; (for he that is hanged {is} accursed

of God;) that thy land be not defiled, which the Lord thy God giveth thee {for} an inheritance

Job 30:3-8 For want and famine {they were} solitary; fleeing into the wilderness in former time desolate and waste. (4) Who cut up mallows by the bushes, and juniper roots {for} their meat. (5) They were driven forth from among {men}, (they cried after them as {after} a thief;) (6) To dwell in the clifts of the valleys, {in} caves of the earth, and {in} the rocks. (7) Among the bushes they brayed; under the nettles they were gathered together. (8) {They were} children of fools, yea, children of base men: they were viler than the earth.

Psa 2:4,5 He that sitteth in the heavens shall laugh: the Lord shall have them in derision. (5) Then shall he speak unto them in his wrath, and vex them in his sore displeasure.

Psa 3:7 Arise, O Lord; save me, O my God: for thou hast smitten all mine enemies {upon} the cheek bone; thou hast broken the teeth of the ungodly.

Psa 5:8-10 Lead me, O Lord, in thy righteousness because of mine enemies; make

thy way straight before my face. (9) For {there is} no faithfulness in their mouth; their inward part {is} very wickedness; their throat {is} an open sepulchre; they flatter with their tongue. (10) Destroy thou them, O God; let them fall by their own counsels; cast them out in the multitude of their transgressions; for they have rebelled against thee.

Psa 6:7-10 Mine eye is consumed because grief; it waxeth old because of all mine enemies. (8) Depart from me, all ye workers of iniquity; for the Lord hath heard the voice of my weeping. (9) The Lord hath heard my supplication; the Lord will receive my prayer. (10) Let all mine enemies be ashamed and sore vexed: let them return {and} be ashamed suddenly.

Psa 7:6,11-16 Arise, O Lord, in thine anger, lift up thyself because of the rage of mine enemies: and awake for me {to} the judgment that {thou} hast commanded. (11) God judgeth the righteous, and God is angry {with the wicked} every day. (12) If he turn not, he will whet his sword; he hath bent his bow, and made it ready. (13) He hath also prepared for him the instruments of death; he ordaineth his arrows against the persecutors. (14) Behold,

he travaileth with iniquity, and hath conceived mischief, and brought forth falsehood. (15) He made a pit, and digged it, and is fallen into the ditch {which} he made. (16) His mischief shall return upon his own head, and his violent dealing shall come down upon his own pate.

Psa 9:3,16-17 When mine enemies are turned back, they shall fall and perish at thy presence. (16) The Lord is known {by} the judgment {which} he executeth: the wicked is snared in the work of his own hands. Higgaion. Selah. (17) The wicked shall be turned into hell, {and} all the nations that forget God.

Psa 11:6 Upon the wicked he shall rain snares, fire and brimstone, and an horrible tempest: {this shall be} the portion of their cup.

Psa 17:13 Arise, O Lord, disappoint him, cast him down: deliver my soul from the wicked, {which is} thy sword:

Psa 18:12-14, 37-42 At the brightness {that was} before him his thick clouds passed, hail {stones} and coals of fire. (13) The Lord also thundered in the heavens, and the Highest gave his voice; hail {stones} and coals of fire. (14) Yea, he sent out his arrows,

and scattered them; and he shot out lightnings, and discomfited them. (37) I have pursued mine enemies, and overtaken them: neither did I turn again till they were consumed. (38) I have wounded them that they were not able to rise: they are fallen under my feet. (39) For thou hast girded me with strength unto the battle: thou hast subdued under me those that rose up against me. (40) Thou hast also given me the necks of mine enemies; that I might destroy them that hate me. (41) They cried, but {there was} none to save {them: even} unto the Lord, but he answered them not. (42) Then did I beat them small as the dust before the wind: I did cast them out as the dirt in the streets

Psa 21:8-12 Thine hand shall find out all thine enemies: thy right hand shall find out those that hate thee. (9) Thou shalt make them as a fiery oven in the time of thine anger: the Lord shall swallow them up in his wrath, and the fire shall devour them. (10) Their fruit shalt thou destroy from the earth, and their seed from among the children of men. (11) For they intended evil against thee: they imagined a mischievous device, {which} they are not able {to perform}. (12) Therefore

shalt thou make them turn their back, {when} thou shalt make ready {thine arrows} upon thy strings against the face of them.

Psa 23:5 Thou preparest a table before me in the presence of mine enemies: thou anointest my head with oil; my cup Runneth over.

Psa 44:5 Through thee will we push down our enemies: through thy name will we tread them under that rise up against us.

Psa 92:7, 9, 11 When the wicked spring as the grass, and when all the workers of iniquity do flourish; {it is} that they shall be destroyed for ever: (9) For, lo, thine enemies, O Lord, for, lo, thine enemies shall perish; all the workers of iniquity shall be scattered. (11) Mine eye also shall see {my desire} on mine enemies, {and} mine ears shall hear {my desire} of the wicked that rise up against me.

Psa 94:12-13 Blessed {is} the man whom thou chastenest, O Lord, and teachest him out of thy law; (13) That thou mayest give him rest from the days of adversity, until the pit be digged for the wicked.

Psa 94:21-23 They gather themselves together against the soul of the righteous, and condemn the innocent blood. **(22)** But the

Lord is my defence; and my God {is} the rock of my refuge. (23) And he shall bring upon them their own iniquity, and shall cut them off in their own wickedness; {yea}, the Lord our God shall cut them off.

Psa 101:8 I will early destroy all the wicked of the land; that I may cut off all wicked doers from the city of the Lord.

Psa 107:10-12,17-18,26-27,39-40 Such as sit in darkness and in the shadow of death, {being} bound in affliction and iron; (11)

Because they rebelled against the words of God, and contemned the counsel of the most High: (12) Therefore he brought down their heart with labour; they fell down, and {there was} none to help. (17) Fools because of their transgression, and because of their iniquities, are afflicted. (18) Their soul abhorreth all manner of meat; and they draw near unto the gates of death. (26) They mount up to the heaven, they go down again to the depths: their soul is melted because of trouble. (27) They reel to and fro, and stagger like a drunken man, and are at their wit's end. (39) Again, they are minished and brought low through oppression, affliction, and sorrow. (40) He poureth contempt upon princes, and causeth them to wander in the wilderness. {where there is} no way.

Psa 108:13,29 Through God we shall do valiantly: for he {it is that} shall tread down our enemies. (29) Let mine adversaries be clothed with shame, and let them cover themselves with their own confusion, as with a mantle.

Psa 110:1,2,6 The Lord said unto my Lord, Sit thou at my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool. (2) The Lord shall send the rod of thy strength out of Zion: rule thou in the midst of thine enemies. (6) He shall judge among the heathen, he shall fill {the places} with the dead bodies; he shall wound the heads over many countries.

Psa 112:8,10 His heart {is} established, he shall not be afraid, until he see {his desire} upon his enemies. (10) The wicked shall see {it}, and be grieved; he shall gnash with his teeth, and melt away: the desire of the wicked shall perish.

Psa 118:7, 10-13 The Lord taketh my part with them that help me: therefore shall I see {my desire} upon them that hate me. (10) All nations compassed me about: but in the name of the Lord will I destroy them. (11) They compassed me about: but in the name of the Lord I will destroy them. (12) They compassed me about like bees: they are quenched as the fire of thorns: for in the name of the Lord I will destroy them. (13) Thou hast thrust sore at me that I might fall: but the Lord helped me.

(19) Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are {these}; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lascivious-ness, (20) Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies, (24) And they that are Christ's have crucified the flesh with the affections and lusts.

Eph 2:1-3 And you {hath he quickened}, who were dead in trespasses and sins; (2) Wherein in time past ye walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience: (3) Among whom also we all had our conversation in times past in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind; and were by nature the children of wrath, even as others.

Eph 4:22-27 That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts; (23) And be renewed in the spirit of your mind; (24) And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness. (25) Wherefore putting away lying, speak every man truth with his neighbour: for

we are members one of another. (26) Be ye angry, and sin not: let not the sun go down upon your wrath: (27) Neither give place to the devil

- **2 Tim 2:22** Flee also youthful lusts: but follow righteousness, faith, charity, peace, with them that call on the Lord out of a pure heart.
- 1 Thess 4:3-7 For this is the will of God, {even} your sanctification, that ye should abstain from fornication: (4) That every one of you should know how to possess his vessel in sanctification and honor; (5) Not in the lust of concupiscence, even as the Gentiles which know not God: (6) That no {man} go beyond and defraud his brother in {any} matter: because that the Lord {is} the avenger of all such, as we also have forewarned you and testified. (7) For God hath not called us unto uncleanness, but unto holiness.
- **Titus 2:12** Teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly, in this present world;
- 1 Pet 2:11 Dearly beloved, I beseech {you} as strangers and pilgrims, abstain from fleshly lusts, which war against the soul;

- 2 Pet 1:4 Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.
- 2 Pet 2:9-10, 14 The Lord knoweth how to deliver the godly out of temptations, and to reserve the unjust unto the day of judgment to be punished: (10) But chiefly them that walk after the flesh in the lust of uncleanness, and despise government. Presumptuous {are they}, selfwilled, they are not afraid to speak evil of dignities. (14) Having eyes full of adultery, and that cannot cease from sin; beguiling unstable souls:....

James 1:14-15 But every man is tempted, when he is drawn away of his own lust, and enticed. (15) Then when lust hath conceived, it bringeth forth sin: and sin, when it is finished, bringeth forth death.

James 4:4 Ye adulterers and adulteresses, know ye not that the friendship of the world is enmity with God? whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God.

1 John 2:15-17 Love not the world, neither the things {that are} in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in

him. (16) For all that {is} in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world. (17) And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of God abideth for eyer.

Mind Control

Isa 26:3 Thou wilt keep {him} in perfect peace, {whose} mind {is} stayed {on thee}: because he trusteth in thee.

Matt 22:37 Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind.

Mark 5:15 And they come to Jesus, and see him that was possessed with the devil, and had the legion, sitting, and clothed, and in his right mind....

Rom 7:22-25 For I delight in the law of God after the inward man: (23) But I see another law in my members, warring against

the law of my mind, and bringing me into captivity to the law of sin which is in my members. (24) O wretched man that I am! who shall deliver me from the body of this death? (25) I thank God through Jesus Christ our Lord. So then with the mind I myself serve the law of God; but with the flesh the law of sin.

Jer 4:31 For I have heard a voice as of a woman in travail, {and} the anguish as of her that bringeth forth her first child, the voice of the daughter of Zion, {that} bewaileth herself, {that} spreadeth her hands, {saying}, Woe {is} me now! for my soul is wearied because of murderers.

Matt 15:19 For out of the heart proceed evil thoughts, murders...

Matt 19:18Jesus said, Thou shalt do no murder....

Matt 22:7 But when the king heard {thereof}, he was wroth: and he sent forth his armies, and destroyed those murderers, and burned up their city.

John 8:44 Ye are of {your} father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his

own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.

John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have {it} more abundantly.

Gal 5:19,21 Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are {these}; (21) Envyings, murders....

1 Tim 1:9 Knowing this, that the law is not made for a righteous man, but for the lawless and disobedient, for the ungodly and for sinners, for unholy and profane, for murderers of fathers and murderers of mothers, for manslayers.

1 Pet 4:15 But let none of you suffer as a murderer, or {as} a thief, or {as} an evildoer, or as a busybody in other men's matters.

1 John 3:15 Whosoever hateth his brother is a murderer: and ye know that no murderer hath eternal life abiding in him.

Colossians 1:9-11 For this cause we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to desire that ye might be filled with the knowledge of his will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding;(10) That ye might walk worthy of the Lord unto all pleasing, being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God;(11) Strengthened with all might, according to his glorious power, unto all patience and longsuffering with joyfulness;

Colossians 4:3, 6, 12 Withal praying also for us, that God would open unto us a door of utterance, to speak the mystery of Christ, for which I am also in bonds:(6) let your speech be alway with grace, seasoned with salt, that
